**Church Street Nut Bread** – *Charleston Receipts*

2 cups flour, sifted	4 tablespoons of shortening
4 slight teaspoons baking powder	1 cup sugar
1 egg	Pinch of salt
1 cup milk	½ cup raisins
½ cup nuts	

- Mix shortening, sugar and egg.
- Add milk and flour combined with baking powder and salt, alternately.
- Then add raisins and nuts.
- Bake for 45 minutes at 350 degrees in loaf pan.
