

# The Junior League of Charleston Announces 2018 Little Black Dress Initiative Local volunteers amplify conversation on poverty and its effects on women

**CHARLESTON, SC** – The Junior League of Charleston (JLC) announces the 2018 Little Black Dress Initiative. The annual campaign will take place during the week of March 12-16, 2018, to encourage conversation and raise funds supporting the JLC mission to empower women and address the effects of poverty in the Charleston community. The JLC will host several events between now and March 16 as part of the Initiative.

The JLC aims to raise \$20,000 as Members wear the same black dress for five consecutive days during the Little Black Dress initiative—a small gesture illustrating the lack of resources many women face due to financial hardship. Charleston County has a 17.8% poverty rate, significantly higher than the national average of 14.8% (DataUSA), and statistics show that single mothers are more likely to suffer poverty's devastating effects.

JLC Members participating in the fundraiser will post to their personal social media accounts daily to bring awareness to the campaign.
